## **Skills training sessions**

Skills training sessions are organized according to the regular schedule as **face-to-face sessions** in skills labs (see instructions below). Face-to-face sessions are provided for small groups of students and the number of seats per session is limited. Registration is therefore required. Each group registers in the LMS Moodle for their set date and time, in the event of an emergency the student can register for an alternative date and/or time that is available. Students are expected to arrive at least 10 minutes before the start of each session (face-to-face, as well as on-line session). Activity during sessions, as well as timely attendance, are graded. Students are required to bring their student ID (ISIC card) to each session, attendance will be recorded.

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#### **Face-to-face sessions**

Information on venue for face-to-face sessions is provided below.

Basic infection control measures during skills training sessions include:

- 1) hand hygiene,
- 2) the use of non-sterile gloves, other measures can be added as needed.

Other details including dress code are specified in SIS.

#### Schedule for winter semester

Patient Care is a two-semester subject. In the winter semester the teaching is carried out through an e-learning course in LMS Moodle (7 online lessons) and face-to-face sessions in skills labs (3 sessions). Each topic is taught over 4 weeks – students **attend only one skills training session** for each topic on the date set for their group.

\*Skills training sessions for Lessons 1 and 2 will be held in the SIM Centre at the Institute of Physiology!

\*Skills training session for Lesson 3 will be held at the Institute of Nursing Theory and Practice in classrooms 1, 2!

Skills training sessions in winter semester are held on Tuesdays except e.g., bank holidays (see detailed schedule on SIS).


