

Credit exam rules – distance form

The following conditions have to be met in order to pass the credit exam.

- Student has to pass written tests in MOODLE. The topics of the tests are the following: cytology, epithelia, connective tissue proper, cartilage, bone, blood, muscle tissue and nervous system and senses. The tests are available under the following link: <https://lms.lfp.cuni.cz/course/view.php?id=271> . The minimal score to pass the exam is 80 % of correct answers in each of the tests. Student can proceed to the next part of the credit exam only when she/he fulfills this requirement till the 15th of May. If student does not pass this part of the credit exam till the given date, she/he will be able to proceed to the next part of the credit exam in September.
- The second part of the credit exam is a practical examination via ZOOM meeting. The teacher will share her/his screen with the slide scan. The student will be asked to point at structures (using “annotation tools” in the ZOOM platform) or to verbally describe the presented tissues.

The teacher will offer up to three terms (dates) during the period between the 18th of May and 26th of June. Students will apply for the practical part via email. The teacher will then schedule an exact time for each student within the given days. Student can only apply for the practical part when she/he passes all the tests in MOODLE with the success rate of at least 80 % (see the requirements above).

Credit exam rules – presence form

The following conditions have to be met in order to pass the credit exam.

- Student has to pass written tests in MOODLE. The topics of the tests are the following: cytology, epithelia, connective tissue proper, cartilage, bone, blood, muscle tissue and nervous system and senses. The tests are available under the following link: <https://lms.lfp.cuni.cz/course/view.php?id=271> . The minimal score to pass the exam is 80 % of correct answers in each of the tests. Student can proceed to the next part of the credit exam only when she/he fulfills this requirement till the 15th of May. If student does not pass this part of the credit exam till the given date, she/he will be able to proceed to the next part of the credit exam in September.
- The second part of the credit exam is a practical examination at the Department of histology and embryology. The practical exam includes identification and description of various tissues on histological slides.

Student can only apply for the practical part when she/he passes all the tests in MOODLE with the success rate of at least 80 % (see the requirements above). The practical part will take place during the credit exam week (18th–22nd of May), when the practical courses are usually scheduled. The teacher will schedule an exact time for each student within the given day, so there is never more than 5 people in the room at the same time.
