

### **Exam rules - distance form**

All rules and requirements from the mentioned website are valid with the exceptions and additions stated below.

Particular changes of the distance form examination will take place in real-time and will consist of:

1. PC test – will be held on a personal PC at student's home, using the MOODLE platform. There will be 40 questions and the test should be completed within 40 minutes. At least 112 out of 160 points will be required in order to pass the test.
2. Schemes of general histology and embryology – scheme description via ZOOM meeting will be done instead of drawing of the schemes as done in the presence form. Student will describe three schemes of general histology and another three schemes of embryology. The tasks will be chosen using the random number generator: <https://los.lf1.cuni.cz/>
3. Practical part – identification and description of the histological slides will be managed via the ZOOM meeting. The teacher will share her/his screen with the slide scan. The student will be asked to point at structures (using "annotation tools" in the ZOOM platform) or to verbally describe the presented tissues. There will be 3 and 2 slides for general medicine and dentistry students respectively. The slide numbers will be chosen using the random number generator: <https://los.lf1.cuni.cz/>
4. Oral part – the student will be interviewed by the teacher via ZOOM meeting. The oral part will consist of three questions from the areas of general histology, special histology and embryology. A preparation for the oral examination will not be allowed and the final evaluation will consider this fact. The question numbers will be selected using the random number generator: <https://los.lf1.cuni.cz/>

The student will be connected to the ZOOM platform throughout all the parts of the final exam. The student will share her/his desktop during the PC test. The student will be on-line with an unmuted microphone and with the camera on during the whole exam. The student will be allowed to draw additional schemes to support his/her description of the presented themes during the oral exam.
